

Student Expectations for Distance Learning

During our extended closure, it is critical that all students continue to learn and make progress in all their core content classes between March 16th and April 17th. April 20th-24th will remain a traditional school break.

During distance learning, students are expected to do the following:

- Check their BPS email every weekday.
- Check the Google Classroom or website for all classes every morning to learn about assignments, assessments, and virtual meetings for the upcoming week.
- Attend all virtual class meetings. (In extraordinary circumstances students may need to miss a class, but they must communicate with teachers ahead of time and make up any missed work.)
- Complete all assignments for each class daily. Please note that after 3pm on Friday, all assignments for the week are considered late. Please note that daily attendance is linked to daily assignment completion, in other words, if you aren't doing the work, you aren't considered to be attending school.
- Attend virtual office hours for all courses they are failing or in which they need additional support.
- Reach out to teachers, advisors, or SSD if feeling overwhelmed or in need of any support on academics or anything else.
